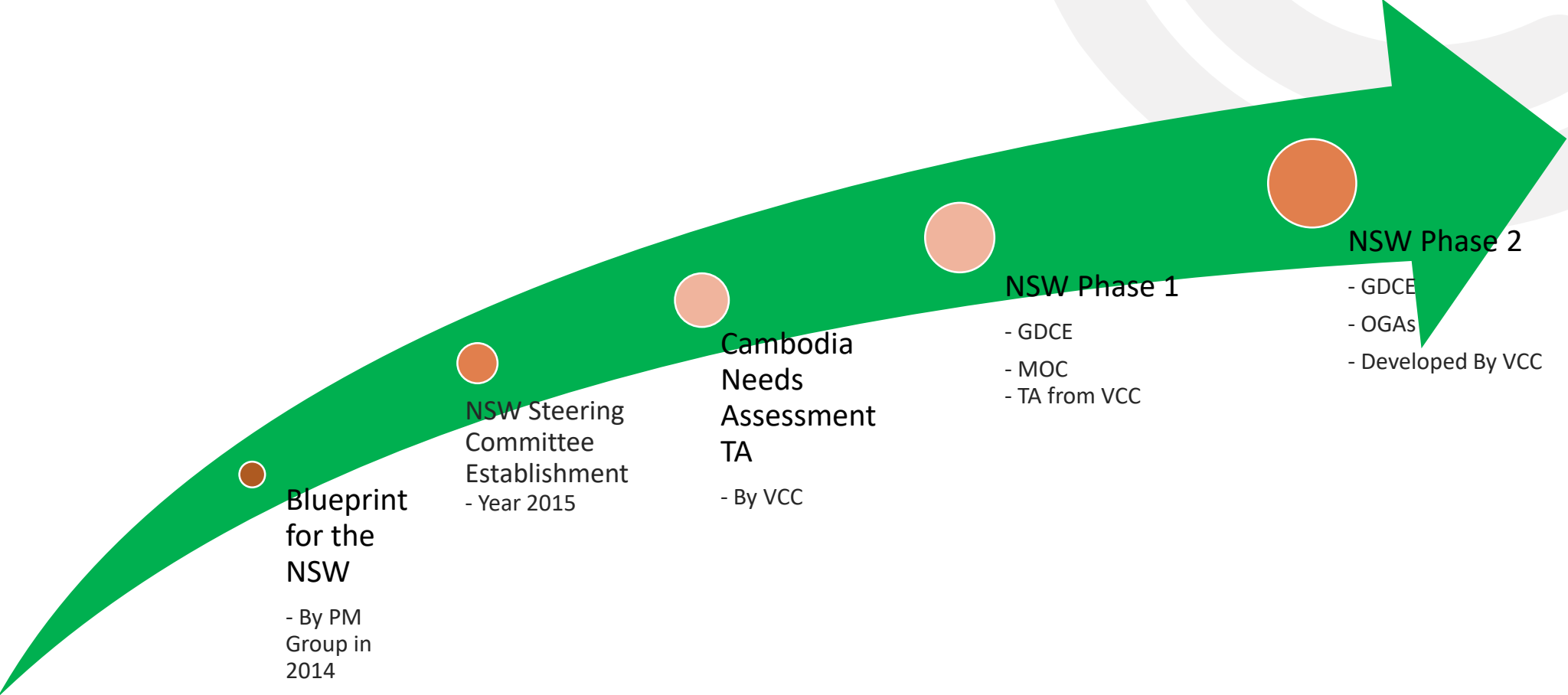
OVERVIEW OF NSW

- Definition: The NSW is a facility that allows parties involved in trade and transport to lodge standardized information and documents with a single-entry point to fulfill all import, export, and transit-related regulatory requirements. For information submitted electronically, individual data elements shall only be submitted once.

OVERVIEW OF NSW

- Cambodia NSW implementation is divided into 3 Phases:
 - Phase I: Connect the E-CO to exchange with ASEAN Member States.
 - Phase II: Enable importers, exporters, agents, and carriers to apply for licenses, permits, certificates, master lists, and other documents (LPCO) or submit cargo-related information in a single-entry point, online and in a timely manner.
 - Phase III: Implement the full National Single Window.

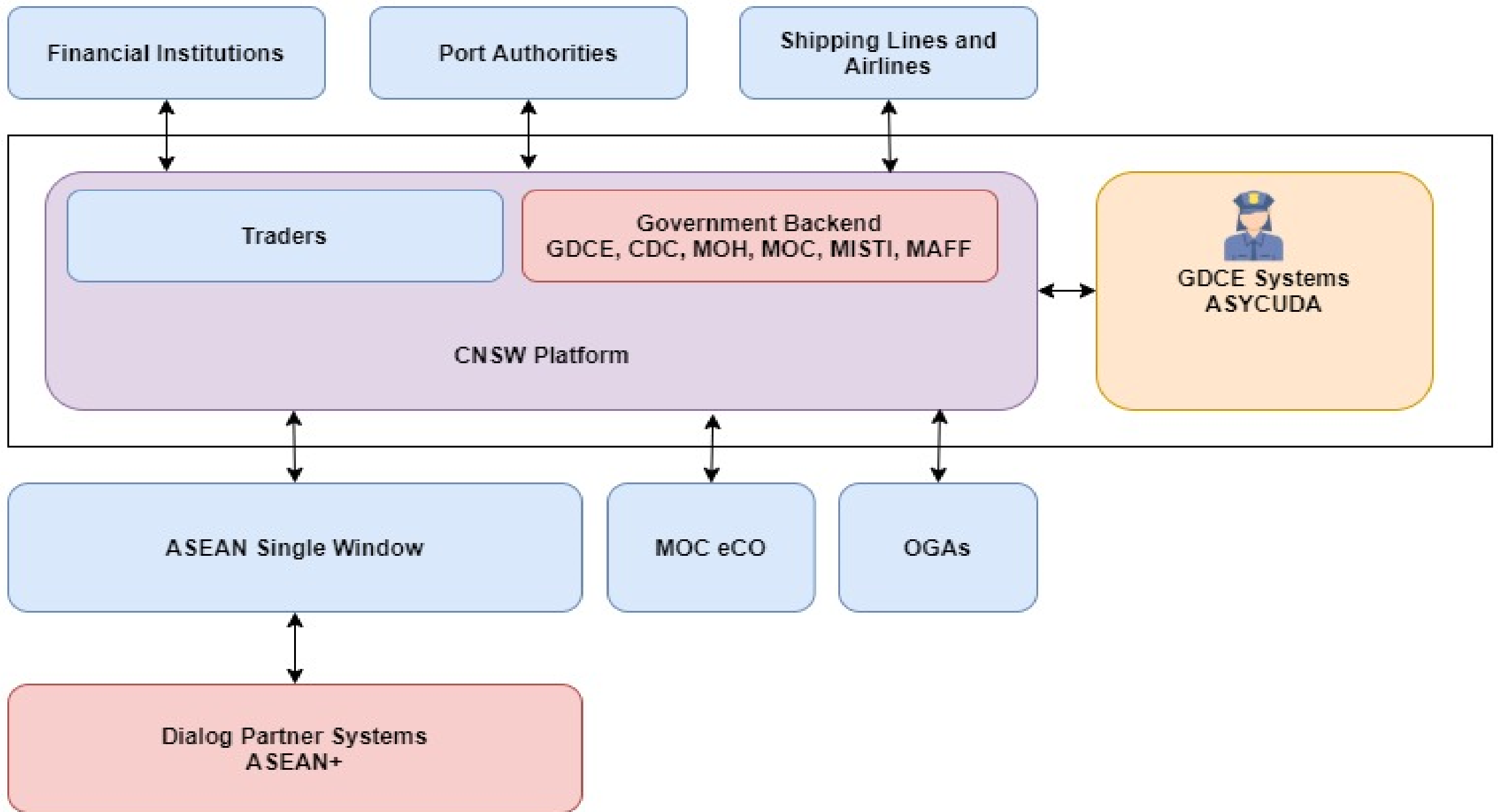

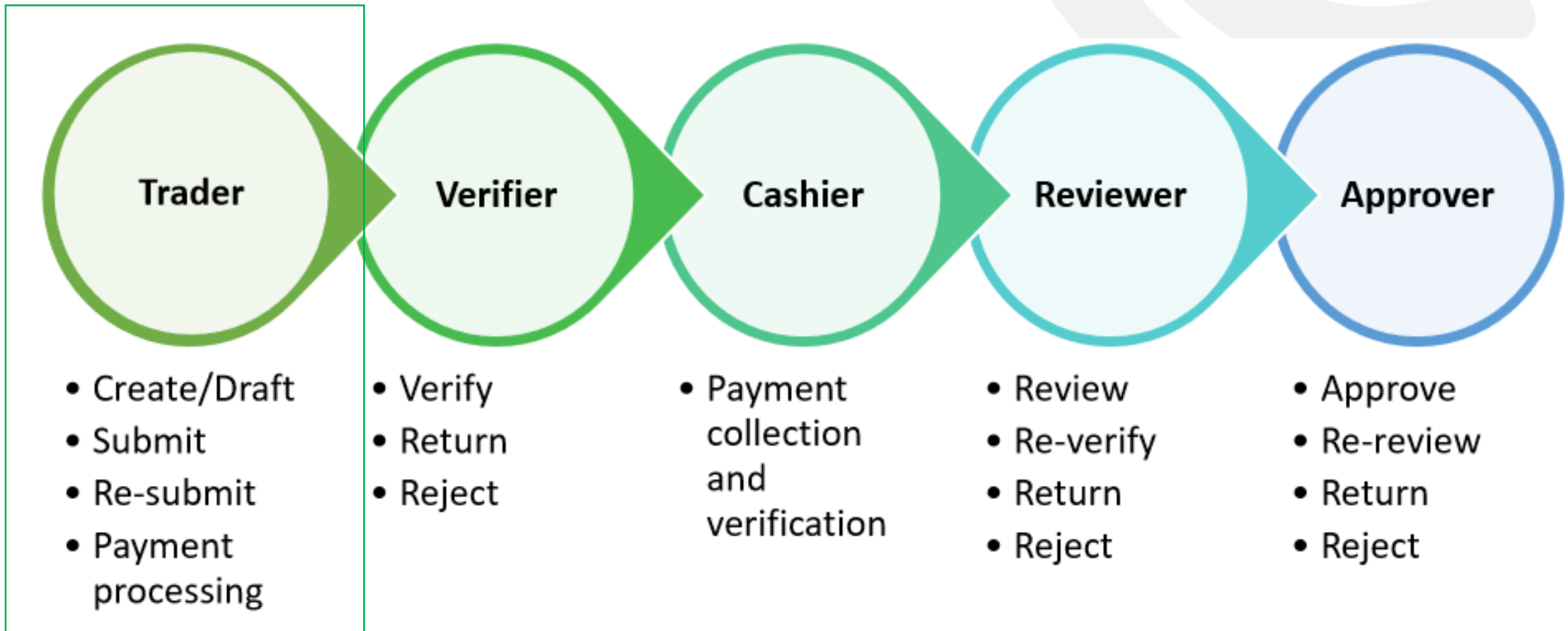

LPCO APPLICATIONS - TYPE

- ***License***: refers to any document that authorizes the import or export of a list of commodities over a period, usually 3, 6, 12 or more months
- ***Certificate***: refers to any document that certifies a specific list of commodities, such as the item's origin or conformance to the international standard
- ***Permit***: refers to any document that authorizes the import or export of a list of commodities in a single shipment.
- ***Others***: refers to other else documents that out of category of LPC which authorized the import or export commodities over a period. Such as Master List and Manifest.

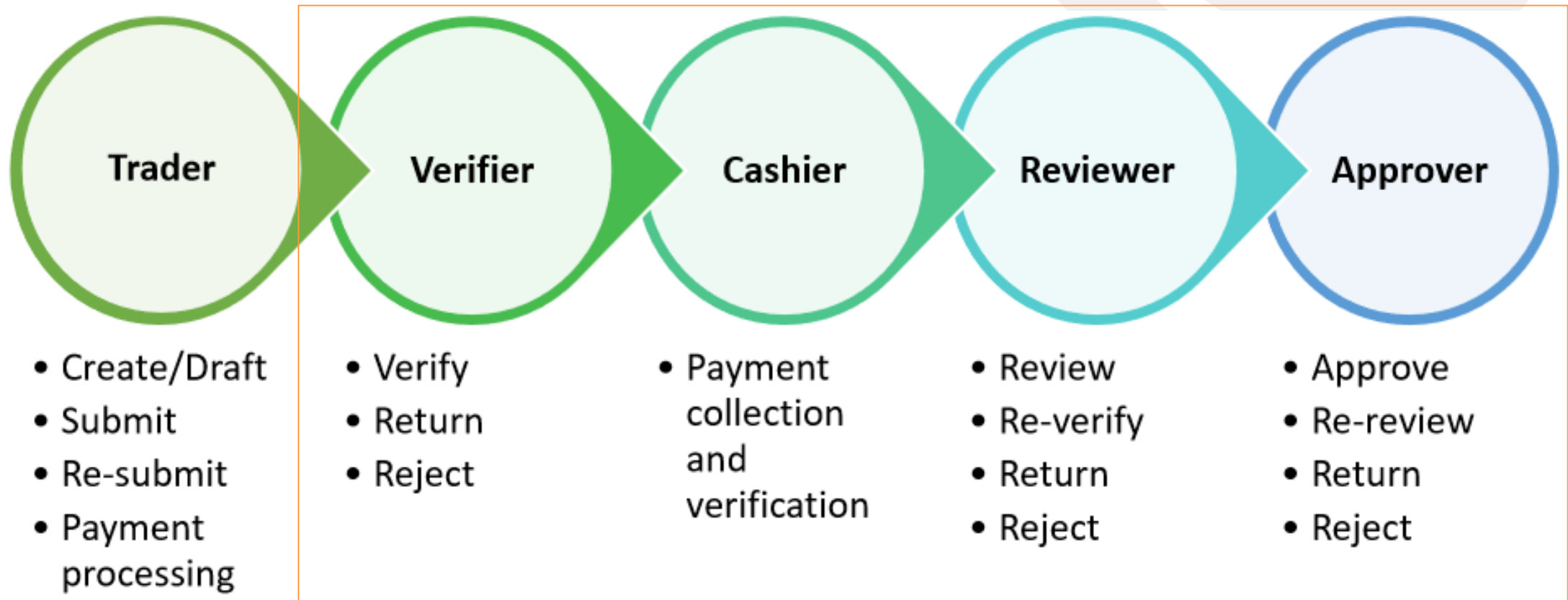
LPCO SUBMISSION

NSW KEYS ACHIEVEMENTS AND ACTIVITIES

- The NSW started accept online document from 1st July 2019
- GDCE, CDC, MOC, MOH, MISTI(MIH) started using system since 2019
- MAFF announced the participating in NSW from 25th May 2021

MAJOR POSITIVE IMPACTS AFTER NSW

- License/Permit/Certificate/Other applications are submitted and process electronically in a Single portal.
- During COVID-19 pandemic, paperless trade activities are being processed without any interruptions. NSW provides safe place for traders and officials to perform their roles accordingly.
- Approved License/Permit/Certificate/Other applications are delivered to respective authorities and systems without having to deliver the hardcopies.
- NSW payment available for traders to pay to respective authorities without having to bring cash directly.
- Traders and Authorities are now able to communicate and seek clarifications within NSW.

NSW – WAY FORWARD

- NSW Phase III development is planned to be started in 2022
- It will covers all Ministries/Agencies who issues LPCO as per Sub-decree 17 on the enforcement of the prohibited and restricted goods
- NSW Secretariate have conducted several meetings with vCargo Cloud PTE (VCC) and requested VCC to recommend new features and technologies

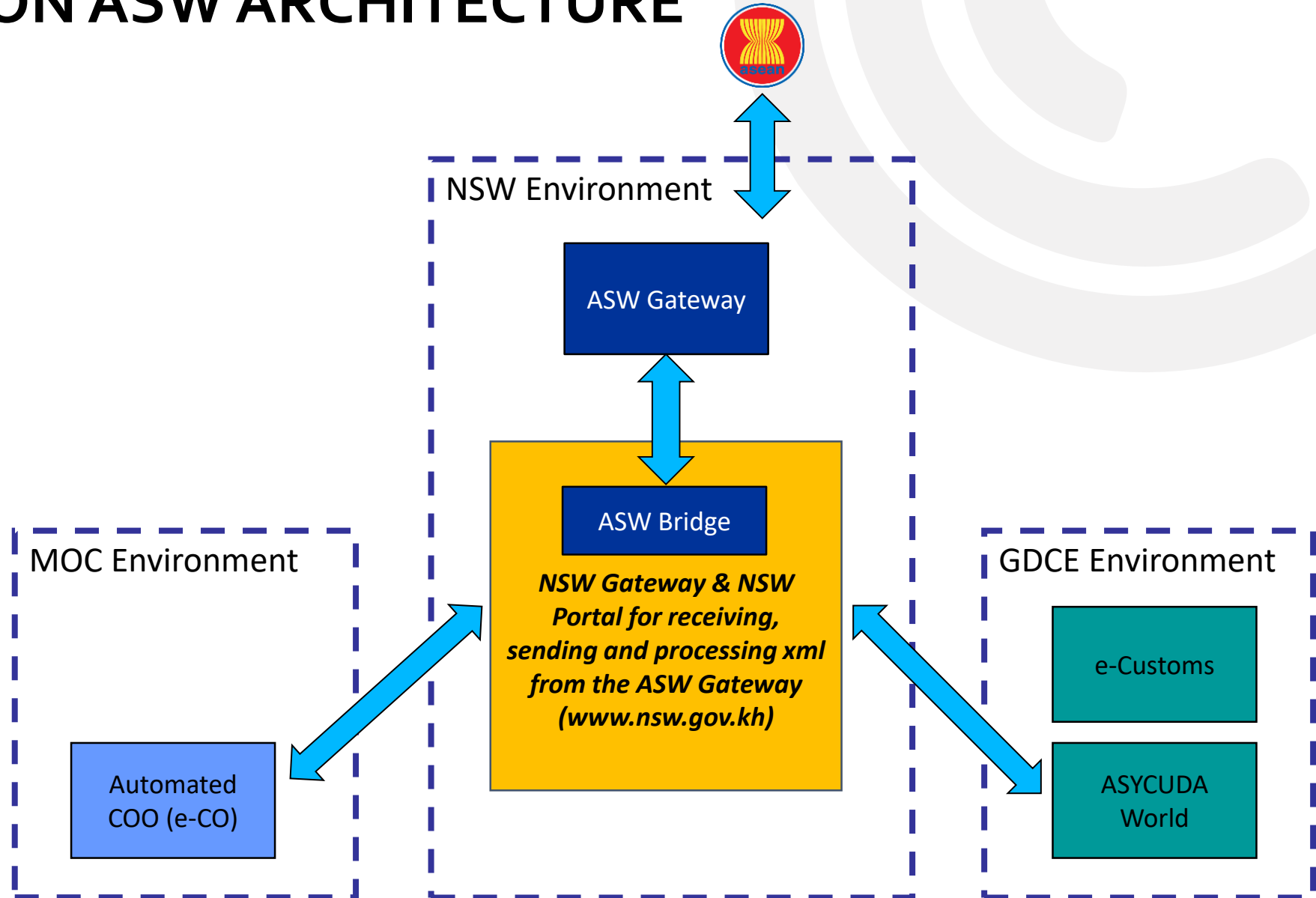

OVERVIEW OF ASW

- The ASEAN Single Window (ASW) is a secured regional environment where National Single Windows of Member Countries exchange trade, transport, and commercial data.
- Established under a legal framework known as the Protocol on the Legal Framework to Implement the ASW (PLF).

ASW KEYS ACHIEVEMENTS AND ACTIVITIES

- Cambodia joined the live operation of the ASEAN Single Window as the 7th member state on 1st July 2019 to exchange the ATIGA e-Form D (Certificate of Origin)
- In December 2020 Cambodia, Myanmar, and Singapore are the first three member states to join the live operation of the ASEAN Customs Declaration Data (ACDD)

ASW – WAY FORWARD

- Enhance the exchanged-ready documents; such as cancellation, generic query, exchange documents inside the common headers
- In preparation for the exchange of the e-SPS certificates (e-Phyto, e-Animal Health, e-Food Safety, ...)
- In the interest to leverage the benefits of the ASW and to expand external relations with Dialogue Partners, the ASEAN Single Window Steering Committee (ASWSC) agreed to invite all interested Dialogue Partners (DPs) to the ASWSC Meetings to discuss about the exchanges of trade-related documents.
